GrainCorp shipping stem for 2018/19 season

1. Short Term Shipping Stem

GrainCorp will open its Short Term Shipping Stem at **9:00am AEST on 29 June 2018** for the shipping period 1 October 2018 – 30 September 2019. At the opening of the 2018/19 Stem, customers will be able to place nomination requests for short term capacity at each our Port Terminals.

Elevation capacity obtained through this process will be subject to entering into a GrainCorp Bulk Wheat and Bulk Non-Wheat Port Terminal Services Agreement for 2018/19. Please note that the vessel nomination booking fee for 2018/19 accepted nominations will remain at \$8.00 per metric tonne, all other major fees will increase broadly in line with CPI by 1.9% (CPI for 12 months ending March 2018)

The below table outlines the **short term elevation capacity** in metric tonnes that will be available for nomination at Non Code Exempt ports and whether capacity is available for nomination application at Code Exempt ports. Please note the elevation capacity is presented in half months.
