**Given the drought conditions this harvest, a significant share of production is expected to remain on farm or be delivered direct to domestic consumers.**

## COMMENTARY:

- Final stages of harvest in Queensland with focus turning to sorghum
- Sorghum planting still underway with further rain needed to encourage a full plant
- Good summer rains will be required to keep plants in good health given extremely hot conditions in QLD and northern NSW
- Harvest activity returning to normal levels across VIC and southern NSW after rain disruption last week
- Continued interest for grain transhipments into QLD and NSW for the first half of next year
