GRAINCORP RECEIVES BULK WHEAT EXPORT ACCREDITATION

GrainCorp today confirmed that the company had received renewal of its bulk wheat accreditation from Wheat Exports Australia.

The accreditation followed publication by the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (ACCC) on Tuesday, 29th September 2009 of its decision to accept the access Undertaking submitted by GrainCorp on 24th September 2009 relating to the provision of port terminal services for bulk wheat by GrainCorp at its 7 bulk grain export terminals.

GrainCorp Managing Director Mr. Mark Irwin said, "We welcome the announcement today by Wheat Exports Australia and the announcement yesterday by the ACCC. The matter of GrainCorp's accreditation, and the manner in which port terminal access is regulated, have now been clarified."

"We are now looking forward to working with customers to make the access regime work."

"We also thank both the ACCC and Wheat Exports Australia, for working with us in a cooperative manner and helping us to meet the new regulatory requirements by the 1st October 2009 deadline."

The accreditation granted by Wheat Exports Australia is for a period of 2 years, and the Undertaking accepted by the ACCC will be in force in its current form for 2 years.
