



# ETA NOMINATION

## To be submitted no later than 21 days prior to the estimated time of arrival of a vessel

Form Instructions – 1 - Complete the relevant fields – 2 - Save the Form – 3 – Email the form to the appropriate Port(s).

### 1 Estimated Time of Arrival (ETA) Nomination – Minimum 21 Day Notice

- 1.1 At any time from the acknowledgement of acceptance of a Cargo Booking by a Client<sup>1</sup>, up to but no later than **21 days prior to the estimated time of arrival of a vessel**, the Client must lodge a formal **ETA Nomination** by updating the original CNA using the GrainCorp Workflow Platform, or this form if that method is not available.
- 1.2 Should a Client fail to comply with the 21 day minimum notice period, the Client will forfeit their Cargo Booking and Cargo Booking Fee<sup>2</sup>.
- 1.3 An ETA Nomination received by GrainCorp outside business hours (8:00 am to 4:00 pm AEST) Monday to Friday or on public holidays is taken to have been received at the commencement of the next business day.

### 2 Assigned Load Date

- 2.1 Following the nomination of a vessel ETA, GrainCorp will notify the Client of an **Assigned Load Date**, which is the date on which GrainCorp has scheduled the commencement of vessel loading, and will update the shipping stem with the relevant information.

### Vessel Nomination

Following the nomination of an ETA, no later than 10 days prior to the Nominated ETA, the Client should lodge with GrainCorp a **Vessel Nomination**.
